## Go on a photo walk with dad

Take your dad on a walk and capture photos of things in his favourite colour. Create a collage in Keynote, then add creative touches with drawings, shapes and emoii.



**Get started:** Add the photos to a slide in the Keynote app. Save your project as an image and share it using AirDrop.

#### Picture your dad's name

Find the letters in your dad's name in books or on signs and take a photo of each one.
Use the photos to create a colourful collage in Keynote that spells out his name.





**Get started:** Crop the letters in the Photos app, then add each photo to a Keynote slide in the right order. Save it as an image and share using AirDrop.

### Emojify your dad

Draw a circle, then add silly eyes, a happy face or eyebrows that show your dad's mood. You can add shapes and images to make it more expressive.





**Get started:** Tap + in the Keynote app to use the drawing tools. Draw your emoji, then add shapes or images to decorate your drawing. Save it as an image and share using AirDrop.

## Take dad on a scavenger hunt

Create a visual list of things around your house. Add emoji, shapes or drawings of each item. Then start hunting for them with dad.





**Get started:** Open Keynote, and tap + in the top right to open the Shapes menu. Add squares to a slide to make a grid, then add a shape, emoji or drawings of the items to each box.

## Create a song for dad



Create a song like you're a music producer. Start with a Live Loops template you like, then come up with your own arrangement.



**Get started:** Choose a Live Loops template in GarageBand. Tap cells to preview and choose sounds for the arrangement, then record the performance. Save the song and use AirDrop to share it.

# Design an app about your dad



Ask your dad about his childhood. What were his fondest memories? What are his hobbies? Then express his story in your app creation.



**Get started:** In Swift Playgrounds, add the About Me sample project. Follow the step-by-step walkthrough to customise it.
